As per the below email I sent to your office on the 23rd of February Amazon has at 12 midnight tonight stopped selling the new book "The Jerilderie Letter Part Two: Australia's Corrupt Prime Ministers" saying that "Temporarily out of stock. Order now and we'll deliver when available. We'll e-mail you with an estimated delivery date as soon as we have more information." The book is print on demand so it does not run out of stock so for Amazon to say it is out of stock is a lie.

Prior to midnight Amazon had been selling it the last few days taking pre-orders, for its publication date of today 28/2/22, since I last emailed your office which fixed the problem a couple hours after you responded. And other websites have not had the same issue.

Once again can you answer the below questions as there is clearly deliberate interference happening at Amazon:
